

## ***2018-2019 Etkin Johnson Student Scholarship Program***

**Applications open Tuesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>**

Following a successful third year, the **Colorado District Council of Urban Land Institute (ULI Colorado)** and **Etkin Johnson** are pleased to announce the 2018-2019 Student Scholar Program to immerse its participants into Colorado's thriving real estate and land use opportunities.

**Program Mission:** To engage college students through mentorship, education and networking with leading ULI members, exposing scholars to key Colorado real estate and land use leaders.

**Eligibility:** Students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate real estate, business, architecture, planning, and related land use/business/real estate programs at Colorado colleges and universities are eligible to apply. ULI Colorado will select 15 students based on completed applications. The program begins in October 2018 and extends through May 2019. Upon successful program completion (one excused absence allowed), each Student Scholar receives a one-year **ULI membership**, effective May 2019, with commensurate benefits.

- Meet leading ULI members one-on-one, targeted to scholars' real estate interests
- The opportunity to attend ULI Colorado committee meetings

**To Apply:** Eligible applicants will be current undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in the affiliated universities in the real estate, construction management, architecture, planning, finance, business or other fields related to real estate and land use.
